The Ozone rinse can also be used as a Rinse for Baby pacifiers and Baby Milk bottles instead of using a using an antibacterial solution and as a hand rinse. The rinse solution is also used to fill Dental unit water bottles and flush water lines with ozone water, and to wipe, dental bench tops and hard surfaces prior to other disinfection. The rinse solution can also be used to rinse fresh food items and food prep surfaces.
